#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2020-418**

#### A RESOLUTION DECLARING VAID, MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NOS. 08 AND 09, BOTH SERIES OF 2020 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF ALANGALANG, LEYTE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 468 (a)(1)(i) of Republic Act 7160 otherwise known as The Local Government Code of 1991, among the powers and duties of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan is "to review all ordinances approved by the Sanggunians of component cities and municipalities;"

WHEREAS, submitted to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for approval, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Alangalang, Leyte, are the following:

- 1. MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 08, Series of 2020, entitled: "AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE PAYMENT OF THE BUSINESS TAXES OF ALL REGISTERED BUSINESSES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ALANGALANG, LEYTE," and

WHEREAS, the Provincial Legal Office was requested to review and submit recommendations on the Subject Ordinances pursuant to Section 481 (3) (vii) of R.A. 7160;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Legal Office, through Atty. Rhea Lina U. Enage, Acting Assistant Provincial Legal Officer, in an Indorsement dated May 11, 2020 recommended to declare the validity of Municipal Ordinance No. 08, series of 2020, pursuant to Section 56 (c) of R.A. 7160, the same being an exercise of the power authorized under Section 167 of the Code;

WHEREAS, in another Indorsement dated May 11, 2020, Atty. Rhea Lina U. Enage likewise recommended for the declaration of validity of Municipal Ordinance No. 09, pursuant to Section 56 (c) of R. A. 7160, the same an exercise of the power authorized under Section 447 (3), (i) of the Code. Provided, That, pursuant to Section 186 thereof, Fees or Charges shall not be unjust, excessive, oppressive, confiscatory, or contrary to declared national policy. And that, a PRIOR PUBLIC HEARING has been conducted for the purpose;

#### MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 08 Series of 2020

Sponsored by: HON. VERNON I. JULBITADO Chairman: Committee on Finance and Appropriations Chairman: Committee on Education

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE PAYMENTOF THE BUSINESS TAXES OF ALL REGISTERED BUSINESSES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ALANGALANG, LEYTE.

WHEREAS, Section 167, of Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that "Unless otherwise provided in this Code, all local taxes, fees, and charges shall be paid within in the first (20) days of January or of each subsequent quarter, as the case may be. The sanggunian concerned may, for a justifiable reason or cause, extend the time for payment of such taxes, fees, or charges without surcharges or penalties, but only for a period not exceeding six (6) months.

WHEREAS, in the light of the Proclamation No. 929, declaring a state of calamity throughout the Philippines due to Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19);

WHEREAS, Proclamation No. 922, Series of 2020 was issued declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines due to COVID-19, enjoining

all

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government agencies and Local Government Units (LGUs) to render full assistance and cooperation;

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2010 the Provincial Government of Leyte, through the Provincial Governor Leopoldo Dominico L. Petilla, issued Executive Order No. 03-2020-03 declaring and placing the entire Province of Leyte under General Community Quarantine and enhancing the implementation of mandatory Precautionary Measures against Covid-19;

WHEREAS, the state of Public Health Emergency, State of Calamity, and the effect of the General Community Quarantine, has severely affected the operational and financial capabilities almost all the businesses in the Alangalang, Leyte thereby an extension in the payment of business Taxes without interests, penalties and charges will give them the opportunity to recoup from their losses;

**NOW THEREFORE,** in view of the foregoing premises upon motion of SB Member Vernon I. Julbitado made duly seconded by SB Member Epifania B. Salazar, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Alangalang, Leyte, in session duly assembled that the implementation of this relief assistance shall be guided by the herein stipulations, to wit:

**SECTION 1. TITLE-** Extension in the collection of business tax on Business Establishment within the Municipality of Alangalang;

**SECTION 2. PERIOD OF EXTENSION** – For all business Establishments in Alangalang, Leyte the Municipal Government shall extend the deadline in the collection of business taxes, from the 20<sup>th</sup> day of April 2020 to June 30, 2020, without the imposition of corresponding surcharges, penalties thereat, but not to include delinguently easements.

SECTION 2.REPEALING CLAUSE. Any provision of Ordinances, Executive Orders Issuances, Rules and Regulations inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 3.EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.** This ordinance shall take effect upon approval and compliance with the applicable statutory provisions.
