WHEREAS, Tech4EdCenter was established in Alangalang in 2019 through the partnership program with Department of Information and Communication Technology (DITC). Alangalang being one of the pilot municipalities in the jumpstarting e-Library of DICT for the Municipal Library.

WHEREAS, The management of Tech4Ed was supervised by the Department of Information and Communication Technology (DITC) and manage by our Tech4Ed Center managers which is trained in handling this center. For the operations of the Tech4Ed Center, a technical staff was assigned which acts as Tech4Ed Center. Manager and tasked to manage the daily operations of the center.

WHEREAS, The Tech4Ed Center was seen as the principal vehicle for bridging the digital divide. As shared facilities. Tech4Ed can provide effective and affordable access to Information Communication Technology (ICT), and empower communities and residents by opening opportunities in education, commerce, tourism, public health, agriculture, and to participate in governance among others.

WHEREAS, All of the Tech4Ed serve as one-stop shops to address the ICT needs of the Community, and offer variety of services, including internet access, office applications, printing, desktop publishing, photocopying, sending email, receiving email and ICT training, among others.

WHEREAS, Based on the agreement, the LGU may charges an amount different services it offers to the public. Policy formulation related to tariff should be through an ordinance and must pass through the process at the Sangguniang Bayan.

WHEREAS, being considered as an income generating unit of the Local Government Unit of Alangalang, Tech4Ed Center operations mustbe profitable, but at the same time, must have a lesser rate as compared to existing interest café in the municipality since part of its mandate is to provide public service.

WHEREFORE, on motion of SB Member Rodolfo R. Cabalona Jr. duly seconded by SB Member Epifania B. Salazar be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Alangalang, Leyte, in session duly assembled that the ordinance prescribing the rates of the services offered by the LGU-Alangalang Tech4Ed Center, to wit;

In a nutshell, the following services are available in the Tech4Ed Center.

1. Internet Access

One of the various Tech4Ed services, Internet service is one of the most accessed services. Clients use the Internet to chat, email, research for school work, find friends download important documents and use government online services Tech4Ed has also educational application for the students, farmers, youth, ALS students, women's group etc. Users also frequent the Tech4Ed to use office applications print, scan and photocopy documents.

2. Basic and Advance Trainings.

The DICT encourage recipients LGU to have ICT literacy training including the use of office applications and how to use the internet. This is one way of increasing the knowledge based on citizens skilled with the use of ICT and at the same time increase the demand for Tech4Ed services. The trainings help to increase the number of community residents who will find the Tech4Ed useful. ICT training not only provides ICT Skills at the community but also serves as a source of revenue to the LGU.

3. Other Services

Other Tech4Ed offer creative services such as video editing, CD-ROM burning, tarpaulin layout, programmes and invitations and other basic services. These services not only increase the viability and sustainability of the Tech4Ed Center but address the informational needs of the community in a single office.
