

"AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE MUNICIPAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT OFFICE OF ALANGALANG, LEYTE, AND ITS PLANTILLA POSITION OF MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENT HEAD I (MDRRMO) STEP1 - SALARY GRADE 24, DEFINING ITS DUTIES FUNCTIONS, AND RESPONSIBILITIES."

APROVED on 3rd and final reading on July 31, 2023

On motion of SB Member Claire G. Yu duly seconded by SB Members Ketchie Rex A. Barrantes, Sheila Antoni-Rebato and SB Member Gina Balderamos.

WHEREAS, Section 12 of RA 10121 otherwise known as the "Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010" mandates that there shall be established an LDRRMO in every province, city, and municipality, and a BDRRMC in every Barangay shall be responsible for setting the direction, implementation, and coordination of disaster risk management programs

within their territorial jurisdiction:



WHEREAS, Section 443 (B) (2) of RA 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 empowers the Sangguniang Bayan to create such other offices as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of the Municipal Government;

WHEREAS, Section 447 (A) (a) of the same code likewise authorize the Sangguniang Bayan to determine the positions, powers, duties, and salaries of officials and employees of the municipality;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 3 and 4 of CSC MC no. 12, s.2022, the 2022 Guidelines and Standards in the Establishment of Organizational Structures and Staffing Patterns in Local Government Units, provides the creation of the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office and the creation of the mandatory position, the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Officer (MDRRMO) respectively;

WHEREAS, the creation of the plantilla position of Municipal Government Department Head I (MDRRMO) Step1 – Salary Grade 24 is in accordance with the Department of Budget and Management Local Budget Circular (DBM LBC) No. 137 otherwise known as the Index of Occupational Services, Positions, Titles and Salary Grades in the Local Government (IOS-LGU), CY 2021 Edition, dated July 13, 2021 under Sec.17, Executive Services and Section 13 of CSC MC no. 12, s.2022, otherwise known as the 2022 Guidelines and Standards in the Establishment of Organizational Structures and Staffing Patterns in Local Government Units;

WHEREAS, Section 5.6 of the NDRRMC, DILG, DBM, CSC JMC No. 2014-1, dated April 4, 2014, the Implementing Guidelines for the Establishment of Local DRRM Offices (LDRRMOs) or Barangay DRRM Committees (BDRRMCs) in Local Government Units (LGUs) provides the standards on position titles and salary grades of the Department Heads (DH), Assistant Department Heads (ADH), and the highest positions below the ADH;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN of the Municipality of Alangalang in session assembled that:

Section 1. NAME OF THE OFFICE. There shall be created a Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office in the Local Government Unit of Alangalang, Leyte.

Section 2. MDRRM OFFICE ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE. The MDRRM Office shall be organized to be composed of the following personnel who may be designated or appointed after passing thru the personnel selection board and by the concurrence of the Sangguniang Bayan in the case of the MDRRM Officer:

a. Municipal Government Department Head I (MDRRMO) Step 1 / Salary Grade 24

Section 3. FUNCTIONS OF THE OFFICE. The Municipal DRRM Office, within their territorial jurisdiction, shall be responsible for setting the direction, development, implementation, and coordination of disaster risk reduction and management programs, and shall perform the following functions and those that may be authorized by the Local DRRM Council:

 Organized and conduct training, orientation, and knowledge management activities on DRRM at the local level;

b. Identify, assess, and manage the hazards, vulnerabilities, and risk that may occur in their locality.

 Identify and implement cost-effective risk reduction measures and strategies;

d. Disseminate information and raise public awareness about those hazards, vulnerabilities, and risks;

e. Take all necessary steps on a continuing basis to maintain, provide, or arrange the provision of, or to otherwise make available, suitably trained and competent personnel for effective civil defense and DRRM in its area;

f. Organize, train, equip, and supervise the local emergency response teams and the accredited community disaster volunteers (ACDVs), ensuring that humanitarian aid workers are equipped with basic skills to assist mothers to breastfeed;

g. Within its area, promote and raise public awareness of, and compliance with RA10121 and legislative provisions relevant to the purpose of the latter:

 Implement policies, approve plans and programs of the LDRRMC consistent with the policies and guidelines laid down in RA 10121; and

 Train the most vulnerable sectors (women, children, senior citizens, and PWD) in DRRM, especially in disaster preparedness.

 Design, program, and coordinate DRRM activities, consistent with the NDRRMC's standards and guidelines;

k. Facilitate and support risk assessments and contingency planning activities at the local level;

 Consolidate local disaster risk information which includes natural hazards, vulnerabilities, and climate change risks, and maintain a local risk map;

m. Conduct research and development initiatives on DRRM;

 Formulate and implement a comprehensive and integrated Local DRRM Plan (LDRRMP) in accordance with the national, regional, and provincial framework, and policies on DRR in close coordination with the Local Development Council (LDC);

Prepare and submit to the Local Sanggunian through the Local DRRM
 Council and the LDC the annual LDRRMO Plan and budget, the proposed
 programming of the LDRRMF, other dedicated DRRM resources, and
 other regular funding source/s and budgetary support of the MDRRMO.

p. Maintain a database of human resource and their capacities, equipment, directories, and location of critical infrastructures such as hospitals and evacuation centers;

 g. Serve as the Secretariat and executive arm of the Local DRRM Council (LDRRMC);

r. Recommend through the LDRRMC the enactment of local ordinances consistent with RA 10121:

Prepare and submit, through the LDRRMC and LDC, the report on the utilization of the LDRRMF and other dedicated DRRM resources to the local COA, copy furnished to the regional director of the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) and the government operations officer of the DILG; and

Involve the most vulnerable sectors (women, children, senior citizens, and t.

PWD) in risk assessment and planning;

Operate a multi-hazard early warning system, linked to DRR to provide u. accurate and timely advice to national or local emergency response organizations and to the general public, through diverse mass media, particularly radio, landline communications, technologies and communication within rural communities;

Conduct continuous disaster monitoring and mobilize instrumentalities and V. entities of the LGUs, CSOs, private groups, and organized volunteers, to utilize their facilities and resources for the protection and preservation of life and properties during emergencies in accordance with existing policies

and procedures;

Develop, strengthen, and operationalize mechanisms for partnership or W.

networking with the private sector, C50s, and volunteer groups;

Respond to and manage the adverse effects of emergencies and carry out X. recovery activities in the affected area, ensuring that there is an efficient mechanism for immediate delivery of food, shelter, and medical supplies for women and children, endeavor to create a special place where internally displaced mothers can help with breastfeeding, feed and care for their babies and give support to each other;

Coordinate other DRRM activities; у.

Establish linkage and/or network with other LGUs for DRR and emergency 7 response purposes;

Establish a municipal DRRM Operations Center; aa.

Give early warning to the most vulnerable sectors (women, children, bb. senior citizens, and PWD) to respond to their needs; and

Respond to and manage the adverse effects of emergencies and carry out CC. recovery activities in the most vulnerable areas, especially in the vulnerable sectors (women, children, senior citizens, and PWD).

CREATION. There shall also be created plantilla position of Municipal Section 4. Government Development Head I (MDRRMO) Step1-SG24 under the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office.

FUNDING. The necessary funding for this plantilla position shall be Section 5. appropriated to cover the salaries and benefits in accordance with the corresponding salary grade and shall be sustained and incorporated in their respective office budgets in the succeeding years.

DUTIES AND RESPOSIBILITIES. The duties and responsibilities of the Section 6. herein aforementioned plantilla position shall be based on the provision of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 10121 Rule 6, Sec. 4.

QUALIFICATION. The Municipal Government Department Head I Section 7. (MDRRMO) Step1-Salary Grade 24 shall be deemed as Department Head with the following Qualification Standards:

a. Must have a Master's Degree in any course;

 Must have four (4) years in a position involving management and supervision, one (1) year of which is relevant to DRRM;

 Must have twenty-four (24) hours of training in management and supervision on DRRM;

d. Must be a Career Service Professional;

e. Must be a Filipino Citizen and a resident of this municipality for at least one (1) year.

Section 8. EFFECTIVITY. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval hereof.

Section 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provision not affected thereby, shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 10. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any ordinance found inconsistent hereof, in whole or part, is hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


